Essav/Poetry Entry Guidelines/Rules:

- Type or neatly handwrite an essay or poem about a situation or individual in your life/community who you think best demonstrates leadership through service (no celebrities please). Give your essay/poem a title. Limit your entry to 250 words or less on 8.5"x11" single sided plain or lined paper.
- The entry must be the original work of an individual student.

Contest Information:

- Judges will examine content, organization, sentence fluency, voice, word choice, and writing conventions in making their decisions.
- Winning entries will be notified after November 8, 2023.
- Arizona State University shall have the right in its sole discretion to use, reproduce, publish or display entries submitted. All entries shall become the property of Arizona State University. Entries will not be returned.
